



Project/Program Title: NAVSUP Data Center Consolidation Team

The federal government through its Federal Data Center Consolidation Initiative has directed an overall review of federal data center assets. In support of this initiative, the Department of Defense and the United States Navy have embarked on a program to eliminate and consolidate data centers over the past ten years. The Chief of Naval Operations established several goals throughout the past ten years that directed specific targeted reductions in Navy legacy data centers and server populations. The Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) – a worldwide logistics organization - had long ago deemed data center operations as a non-core function and has been a leader in the Navy's data center consolidation effort. NAVSUP's Business Systems Center established a team of highly qualified and motivated Information Technology professionals who accepted the challenge to successfully eliminate thirty legacy data centers and migrate any remaining application hosting requirements to Department of Defense or Navy enterprise hosting facilities.
